

"The Quartet" was established in 1977 by Pastor John Wimberly, who felt that the choir needed the inspiration of some youthful voices and looked to the University for personnel. Christ Presbyterian Church is one of the few churches in Madison to offer this "on-the-job" training to talented young singers who are working on advanced music degrees at UW-Madison or are recent graduates. The Quartet provides leadership in the choir, solos in Sunday worship and other services, and serve as soloists in larger choral works. Former Quartet members are singing in opera houses all over the world and on Broadway, teaching in school K-12 music programs, directing their own church choirs, teaching voice in private studio or at the college level.
